“Light-Touch” Labour Regulation as a State Government Response to WorkChoices

He has written extensively on mechanisms of labour regulation, and the intersection between state-based regulation and corporate governance. John is the Secretary of the Australian Labour Law Association, and a member of the editorial committee of the Australian Journal of Labour Law.

John will speak about his research into the actual and potential use by States of procurement contracts, financial subsidies, codes of conduct and ‘best practice’ guidelines as techniques for regulating labour rights and standards outside the public sector.
