Work Choices and Victorian Employers and Employees

The Federal Government has embarked on a radical change to regulating industrial relations in Australia. Mr Tim Lee will discuss Victoria's Response to Work Choices, including the States' High Court challenge, the Workplace Rights Advocate and new legislation to protect public sector workers.

Tim Lee was appointed Deputy Secretary of Industrial Relations Victoria in July 2005. During his previous appointments Tim was Director of Industrial Relations for the Victorian Department of Human Services and also Senior Adviser to the Minister for Local Government and WorkCover.
