Which Way Forward for Dispute Resolution: ‘Work Choices’ or ‘Fair Work Australia’?

In this seminar, Anthony will examine the operation of the voluntary dispute resolution framework under the Work Choices legislation, focusing on its impact on the Australian Industrial Relations Commission. The new arrangements for alternative dispute resolution through private ADR providers will also be considered. The ALP's proposal to establish Fair Work Australia as the new body responsible for dispute resolution (and several other functions) will also be analysed, including its implications for the future handling of workplace disputes and grievances in Australia.

Dr Anthony Forsyth is a Senior Lecturer in Workplace Law and Director of the Corporate Law and Accountability Research Group, in the Department of Business Law and Taxation, Monash University. Anthony is also an Advisory Board Member of the Australian Institute of Employment Rights, and a Research Associate of the Centre for Employment and Labour Relations Law at the University of Melbourne.
