The next federal election looms as a watershed for industrial relations and labour regulation in Australia. **Andrew Stewart** will review Labor's IR policies, what they might mean in practice - and what constitutional powers might be used to put them in place. He will also discuss some of the dilemmas confronting the Coalition as it decides where to go with labour market reform after the introduction of the 'fairness test'.

Andrew Stewart is a Professor of Law at Flinders University and a Legal Consultant to the law firm Piper Alderman. He is one of Australia's leading experts in labour relations and employment law, and is the co-author (with Breen Creighton) of the popular text *Labour Law*. Andrew has played a prominent role in the public debate over the Work Choices legislation, and has spoken and written widely about its implications for businesses, workers and unions. His most recent books are *Work Choices: What the High Court Said*, co-authored with George Williams and published by Federation Press, and *CCH's Understanding Independent Contractors*.
