Employment Law – An Update

With Professor Andrew Stewart who is the John Bray Professor of Law at the University of Adelaide and a Legal Consultant to Piper Alderman, Solicitors.

Andrew is one of the country's foremost experts on employment law and workplace relations.

He will review recent case law on issues such as:

- wrongful or unfair dismissal
- the duty to preserve "trust and confidence" in the employment relationship
- the ownership of employee inventions
- the approval of workplace agreements
- the assessment of penalties for breach of awards or other workplace laws
- and the status of employers as trading corporations

He will also explain the process for "modernising" awards that is currently under way in the Australian Industrial Relations Commission, and look ahead to the next round of legislative changes expected from the Rudd Government later in the year.
